



Student Led Grant FAQs:

- This program is designed to support HSE21 instructional framework and best practices to provide students with an opportunity to use their student voice and choice to create a relevant learning experience.
- Projects can support a variety of ideas, as long as they are student-driven in their creation. Some examples include:
 - units of study within a classroom or grade level through inquiry-driven study
 - support an identified need within a school or local community
 - support a service-learning project
- Project ideas should originate between a group or class of students and an HSE educator who will act as a mentor and facilitator through throughout the project duration.
- Students should be engaged in the creation of idea, proposal drafting, and project implementation using guidance and support from their mentor.
- However, **the HSE employee mentor should be main contact submitting application via Smarter Select.**
