This program is designed to support HSE21 instructional framework and best practices to provide students and staff with an opportunity to utilize student voice and choice to create a relevant learning experience.

Applications are available for BOTH HSE staff and students!

If students are applying they should work with an HSE Schools staff member to officially submit their application. who will act as a mentor and facilitator throughout the project duration. Students should be engaged in the creation of idea, proposal drafting, and project implementation using guidance and support from their mentor. However, the HSE employee mentor should be main contact submitting application via Smarter Select.

Projects can support a variety of ideas, as long as they are rooted in innovation. Some examples might include:

- units of study within a classroom or grade level through inquiry-driven study
- support an identified need within a school or local community
- support a service-learning project

HSEF does not typically fund:

- highly consumable supplies including apparel/food/party supplies, incentives or monetary prizes,
- basic classroom or student needs including curriculum books without an innovative program
- courses taken by staff for credit toward a degree or advanced salary schedule
- compensation and benefits for employees or students, travel expenses
- student clubs

HSEF also considers sustainability and does not typically fund projects that require consumables that do not result in long term impact.
